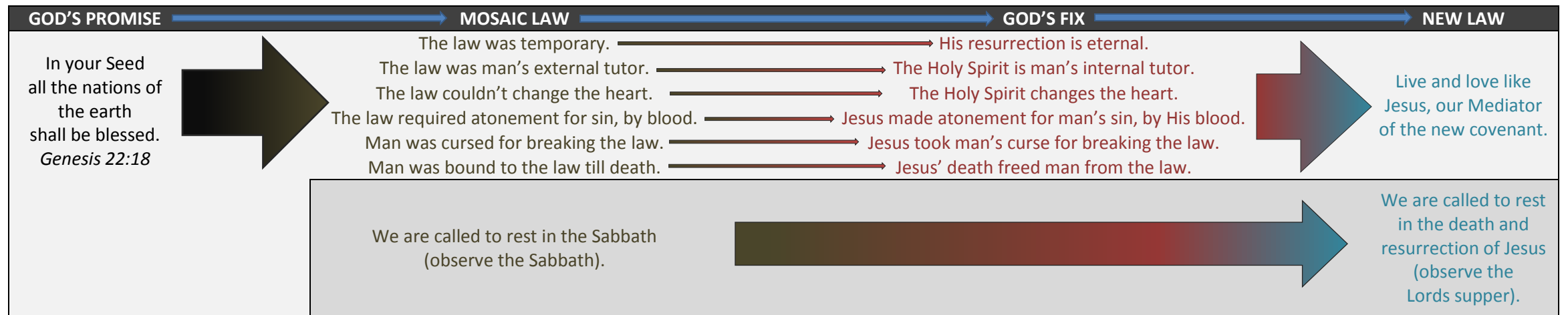







**God wants a relationship with us.

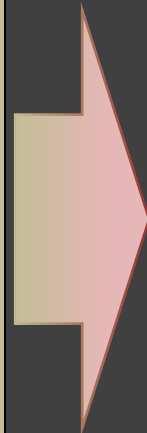

<b>The law was temporary.</b>		<b>His resurrection is eternal.</b>
<p>“What purpose then does the law serve? It was added because of transgressions, till the Seed should come to whom the promise was made.” Galatians 3:19</p>		<p>“but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.” Hebrews 9:12</p> <p>“not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another – He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.” Hebrews 9:25-28</p>
<b>The law was man's external tutor.</b>		<b>The Holy Spirit is man's internal tutor.</b>
<p>“Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.” Galatians 3:24</p>		<p>“But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.” Jeremiah 31:33</p>
<b>The law couldn't change the heart.</b>		<b>The Holy Spirit changes the heart.</b>

<b>The law required atonement for sin, by blood.</b>		<b>Jesus made atonement for man's sin, by His blood.</b>

## NEW LAW

### Live and love like Jesus, our Mediator of the new covenant.

“But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.” Hebrews 8:6

“For where there is a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a testament is in force after men are dead, since it has no power at all while the testator lives. Therefore not even the first covenant was dedicated without blood.” Hebrews 9:16-18

“Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God, who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.” 2 Corinthians 3:5-6
